What is Proxy Access?

Proxy access allows you to use the NHS App to manage someone else's healthcare, like your child's. It's perfect for parents and carers who want to keep track of their child's appointments, prescriptions, and health information. You can also use proxy access for other relatives, like an older parent, or anyone else you care for, if they are registered at the same GP practice as you.

Benefits

- Manage your Appointments: Never miss a vaccination or check-up.
- Repeat Prescriptions: Request a repeat prescription with just a few taps.
- GP Health Record Access: Stay informed about your child's test results and medical history.
- 24/7 Access to NHS 111 online for medical help.

Getting Set Up

Proxy access can be given to parents, legal guardians or carers, so long as you are both registered with the same GP practice in England. Anyone aged 13 and over needs to consent to you having access to their records.

- Contact your GP practice to request access – Identity documents will be needed.
- Once approved, your profiles will be linked, and you'll be able to log into the app and switch profiles to view your child's information.
